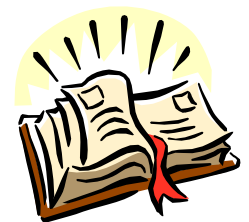

SAFETY

Your child's safety is very important to us. You'll be glad to know that there are over 100 adults and teens helping at Safari. We do still need your cooperation to ensure the children will be safe.

***Let us know how we can help if it is impossible for you to come into the church basement in the morning or to the parish center at dismissal. An adult helper will get your children for you.**

ARRIVAL- Please walk your children into the church basement (Hoban Hall) each morning and sign the registration form on their table detailing who will be picking up your child. Be certain their leader or helper knows they have arrived.

DISMISSAL- You must come into the parish center each day to pick up your children and sign out those in PK through 3rd grade. Make arrangements with 4th-6th grade children to meet in the hallway. They will not be allowed to go into the parking lot w/o an adult. PK through 2nd grade classrooms are on the main floor, 3rd & 4th are on the top floor and 5th & 6th are in the basement. Signs for each classroom is outside the door.

There will be a police officer assisting with crossing High St. at 11:30. He will be directly in front of the Parish Center along with several volunteers in orange crossing guard vests. Please use this to cross and obey the guards.

PARKING LOTS

Parking is available in the lot east and west of the parish center. Parking is also available in the High Street United Methodist lot directly across from the parish center. **The officer will only allow right turns out of these lots.** This assures safety and keeps the flow of traffic moving. Parking is also available in the lot across from the church. Again, if you use this lot please cross at the crosswalk back by the parish center. The High and Spring St. corner has been the site of many accidents. Please consider car pooling with others.

STREET PARKING

Do not park on the street close to the driveways. Drivers coming out of the lot cannot see to exit. **The officer will ask you to move.** No parking is allowed in front of the parish center, as this is our crosswalk. Please respect the police officer; he is trying to keep us all safe.
